

- 3.6" x 7.7" paver — \$100 * Maximum 15 characters per line

- Tree — \$1,500 (stone sizes vary) * Maximum 15 characters per line (1 Available)

A 3x12 grid of 36 empty square boxes, arranged in three rows and twelve columns.
